Short description		This Act (as amended by Law No. CXXXIII of 2007) provides for the prospecting of mineral raw materials, and for the exploration and exploitation of mineral resources. The Minister shall designate concession areas and invite a concession tender. The beneficiary of the concession shall perform the mining activity in compliance with the requirements prescribed in the Act. Mining activities shall be carried out by mining entrepreneurs in possession of a licence issued by the mine supervision. Licences shall be granted for the prospecting for mineral raw materials, for the exploration, exploitation and utilization of waste stock-piles, and for the construction and operation of hydrocarbon conveying pipelines. The State shall be entitled to a mining royalty for the mineral raw material exploited by the mining entrepreneur as well as for the geothermal energy generated. The Act further makes provision for the following: security zones and protective pillars; mine plans; safety of mining; landscape rehabilitation; mine damages; right to use water; fines; state supervision of mining activities; etc.
